The Census

A census is an official count of the number of people living in Red Deer.

The City conducts a municipal census:

- · To establish the total population of our city.
- To help The City understand community needs as we move forward with future growth and development.
- To calculate the amount of provincial grant money Red Deer receives, which is based on the total population of our community multiplied by a dollar figure.

Census data is also used by a variety of outside agencies such as communities, businesses, charities and research groups.

In 2013 and 2014 The City also collected census data online. The response rate for the on-line portion of the Census for 2013 was 31% and it increased to 40% in 2014.

What information was collected in 2014?

Enumerators asked Red Deer citizens the following questions:

- · How many people live in your household?
- What is the gender of each person living in your household?
- · What is the year of birth of each person living in your household?

Audit

In compliance with Municipal Affairs, The City undertook a Quality Assurance Audit, by completing 1,000 follow-up phone calls to verify the accuracy of census results.

Will a census be conducted in 2015?

Red Deer is still growing, which means our population changes all the time. The City plans to conduct a basic census in the year 2015; however, this will be discussed further during the 2014 mid-year budget review.

The Results: Red Deer's Total Population

= 98,585

Red Deer is home to 1,476 new residents – an increase of 1.5 per cent over 2013. That brings Red Deer's total population to 98,585.

The strongest growth occurred in the areas of Vanier Woods with 603 new residents and Timberlands with 441 new residents.

Slight declines in population were experienced in the other areas, which may indicate children in those areas have grown up and left the family home, or residents have relocated to another area in the city and their previous residence is still vacant.

The average age of people living in Red Deer is 31 with a 48.3 per cent female population and 48.7 per cent male population.

The City thanks all citizens who participated in the 2014 Municipal Census.






