

Council Recognition

Policy Type: GOVERNANCE PROCESS | GP-C-2.5

Council members will be formally recognized for their service at the time of their election and upon their departure from Council.

I At time of Election

- (I) At an appropriate time following the swearing-in, first-time elected members of Council are presented with an official City of Red Deer Council lapel pin.
- (2) A permanent record of this formal recognition of Council members is kept in the Office of the Mayor and Council.

2 Upon Departure from Council

- (I) The City may host a dinner, at an appropriate time, following the completion of a Council member's term.
 - (a) Current and departing Council members may bring one guest each to this dinner.
- (2) A commemorative gift, up to a value of \$250.00, may be presented at this time for a Council member elected on or prior to October 18, 2021.
- (3) A commemorative gift, up to a value of \$500.00, may be presented at this time for a Council member elected after October 18, 2021.
- (4) Council reserves the right to withhold any form of recognition if a member is relieved of their office.
