

Community Culture Development – Canada 150 One-Time Opportunities Fund

April 20, 2017

1. What is the Community Culture Development Canada 150 One-Time Opportunities Fund?

The Fund is for activities or initiatives to be held in Red Deer no later than December 31, 2017, that celebrate the 150th Anniversary of Confederation in a way that will foster a sense of belonging, support, meaningful reconciliation and leave a lasting legacy now and for future generations.

2. Canada 150 One-Time Opportunities Fund Outcomes:

Applications must meet at least one of the following Canada 150 outcomes:

- a) **Encourage** participation in community activities and events to mark Canada's 150th anniversary of Confederation;
- b) **Inspire** a deeper understanding about the people, places and events that have shaped our community; or
- c) **Build** a vibrant and healthy community with the broadest possible engagement of all Red Deerians, including indigenous peoples; groups that reflect our cultural diversity, youth and official language minorities.

3. Who is eligible for the program?

Not-for-profit organizations operating within Red Deer are eligible to apply for funding towards the cost of a Canada 150 activity or initiative which will take place no later than December 31, 2017.

4. How much funding is available for the 2017 funding year?

A total of \$25,000 in one-time funding has been made available for Canada 150 related initiatives. Once this funding has been expended, no additional funding will be available.

5. What is the maximum amount of Canada 150 funding that can be applied for?

The maximum amount of funding per application is \$5,000.

7. How can I apply?

The combined Canada 150 One-Time Opportunities Fund Guide and Application form is available on The City's website. Grant applications are accepted on an ongoing basis until December 31, 2017 or until funds have been fully expended.

8. Are there any other Community Culture Development funding categories?

Yes, there are two on-going categories, Culture Development and Culture Opportunities.

- The Culture Development category supports longer term projects, including operational funding; Multi-year funding for up to three years may be applied for within this category; Intake for applications runs November 1 - December 15, annually.
- The Culture Opportunities Category supports unforeseen short-notice and or one-time cultural opportunities. There is no deadline for Culture Opportunities category and applications will be accepted until funding is fully expended for the year.
