

**ANNUAL POLICING PLAN - 2015/2016**  
**THIRD QUARTER UPDATE (OCTOBER 1 - DECEMBER 31, 2015)**  
**UPDATES REPRESENT YEAR TO DATE RESULTS**

RCMP develops objectives for the Annual Policing Plan every year in consultation with The City of Red Deer Council and administration. These objectives reflect The City and RCMP’s policing priorities. RCMP will report back to City Council and the community on a quarterly basis

**OBJECTIVES**

**OBJECTIVE 1:** Reduce the Impact of Organized Crime through an intelligence led, coordinated and multi-jurisdictional approach – the Regional Priorities Crimes Task Force.

Measurement: Identify and disrupt four medium or high level criminal networks

**OBJECTIVE 2:** Reduce Crimes Against Persons

Measurement: Identify and monitor three Domestic Violence Offenders

Measurement: Identify and monitor five Prolific Offenders.

**OBJECTIVE 3:** Reduce Property Crime

Measurement: Quarterly Fraud presentations and media releases, a total of five throughout the year.

**OBJECTIVE 4:** Contribute to Safer Youth

Measurement: Identify and work with five high risk youth between the ages of 12 - 17 years in order to build relationships and reduce potential victimization / criminality.

Measurement: Identify and work with five chronic missing youth to reduce related calls for service, build relationships and reduce potential victimization.

**OBJECTIVE 5:** Contribute to Safe Roads

Measurement: A 5% decrease in injury accidents by targeting the root cause at identified high crash locations.

Measurement: A 5% increase in Impaired Driving charges.

**THIRD QUARTER UPDATE**

**OBJECTIVE 1:** Nine (9) medium level networks have been disrupted.  
Target exceeded.

**OBJECTIVE 2:** Three (3) domestic violence offenders and fifteen (15) prolific offenders have been identified and are being monitored.  
Targets met and exceeded.

**OBJECTIVE 3:** Four (4) presentations related to current scams and frauds have been provided.  
Target met.

**OBJECTIVE 4:**

- Community Policing Unit has implemented a new initiative in partnership with Red Deer Youth Coalition Committee to support youth identified as a “medium risk.”
- A mentorship program has been developed and implemented whereby high school students (12) are paired with younger students (15). The program is designed to provide positive role models to youth experiencing social, anxiety and behavioural challenges.
- Ten (10) chronic missing youth have been engaged.

Targets exceeded.

**OBJECTIVE 5:**

- A 31% decrease in injury accidents at high crash locations compared to 2014.
- A 21% increase in impaired driving charges compared to 2014.

Targets exceeded.
