
THE CENSUS

A census is an official count of the number of people living in Red Deer. The City conducts a municipal census:

- ✓ To establish the total population of our city
- ✓ To help The City understand community needs as we move forward with future growth and development
- ✓ To calculate the amount of provincial grant money The City receives, which is based on the total population of the community

Census data is also used by a variety of outside agencies such as community groups, businesses, charities and research groups.


The City plans to conduct a census annually.



INFORMATION COLLECTED IN 2019

Residents were asked the following questions:

- What is the total number of residents in your household?
- What is the sex of each person living in your household?
- What is the year of birth of each person living in your household?
- What is the primary mode of transportation that each person, 16 years or older, in your household uses when traveling around Red Deer?



QUALITY ASSURANCE AUDIT

In compliance with Alberta Municipal Affairs' requirements, municipalities are required to perform quality assurance checks by randomly contacting residences that were enumerated by an enumerator. The phone calls verify that the residence was visited by an enumerator and provide a check on the total number of residents question.

REVIEWING RESULTS

Missing: missing data occurs because of nonresponse, when no information is provided, the information is not available or when the information is collected from someone other than the usual resident (neighbour, landlord, building manager)

Rather not say: resident(s) preferred not to provide a response

No data entered: the information was not collected

Response of 0: the information was collected but response is 0

101,002

Red Deer is home to 101,002 residents, an increase of 1.2% from 2016.

Neighbourhoods which experienced the strongest growth in 2019:

- 823 new residents in Timberlands/Stone/Ridge/College Park;
- 629 new residents in Lancaster Meadows/Green/Lonsdale/Laredo;
- 348 new residents in Clearview Ridge; and
- 283 new residents in Vanier Woods/Vanier East.





OCCUPANCY SUMMARY



A person is considered to be a usual resident of the dwelling where they usually live and to which they intend to return when they have been absent.

The following are examples of when a person is not considered to be a usual resident of the municipality:

- A student who lives in the city of Red Deer during the school year or for their summer job but returns to live with their parents (example: on weekends, semester breaks after completing their studies) should be enumerated at their family's residence even if the student spends most of the year in the city of Red Deer.
- A person who works in the city of Red Deer but returns to their family's residence on weekends and days off work should be enumerated at their family's residence even if the person spends most of the year in the city of Red Deer.

Non-contacted dwellings are defined as a dwelling where no contact was made with a member of the household. Non-contacted dwellings are excluded from occupancy rate calculation.

A vacant dwelling is defined as a dwelling that is suitable and available for occupancy and does not include those dwellings under construction, renovation, unresponsive dwellings or vacant lots.
