Required Items

1. A completed Development Permit Application – Change of Use
 2. All documents listed on the Development Permit Application – Change of Use Permit Requirement List
- **In addition to the above the following is required:**
3. A site plan illustrating the location and separation distances from the proposed Cannabis Retail Sales use to those uses identified in Section 5.7.12 of the *Land Use Bylaw*, with the exception of other Cannabis Retail Sales.
 4. A site plan illustrating compliance with applicable provincial setbacks.
 5. Written confirmation from the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (AGLC) that confirms the applicant has satisfied eligibility requirements to sell Cannabis in Alberta.

APPLICANT

I understand the following:

- The City reserves its right to deem an application complete or incomplete within 20 days of the submission of the Development Permit.
- An application is deemed complete if the submission contains the documents and other information necessary to review the application.
- An application which has been deemed incomplete will be returned to the Applicant and re-submission will be required.
- The City reserves its right to approve or refuse a Development Permit application within 40 days from the date an application is deemed complete.
