### WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THIS BYLAW:

Fireworks Bylaw 3626/2019 regulates the sale, possesion and use of fireworks (consumer, display and pyrotechnic) in city limits. This bylaw ensures fireworks are used safely by persons with proper training and qualifications.

## WHAT THIS MEANS FOR RESIDENTS:

A permit is required to discharge fireworks. Permit requirements include:

- Permit holder is a Fireworks Supervisor or Pyrotechnician.
- Written consent from land owner where fireworks will be discharged.
- Description of fireworks event and site plan.
- Payment of permit and inspection fee(s): \$58.25 for permit, \$116.50 for site inspection and \$233 for after hours site inspection.

The sale of fireworks is not permitted in the city.
