- WHEREAS:** The work of the Alzheimer’s Society supports The City of Red Deer’s commitment to ensuring the safety, wellness, and inclusion of all in our community; and
- WHEREAS:** The “Alzheimer’s Society Alberta and Northwest Territories” recognizes January 2021 as “Alzheimer’s Awareness Month”.
