**WHEREAS:** A healthy, professional news media is essential for the proper

functioning of civil society and democracy at the local, regional,

federal and international levels,

**WHEREAS:** The Public Policy Forum declares — on its website for the 2017

report The Shattered Mirror: News, Democracy and Trust in the

Digital Age — that "real news is in crisis" in this country, and

**WHEREAS:** Canada's federal government acknowledged in its 2019 budget (p.

173) that "A strong and independent news media is crucial to a

well-functioning democracy,"

WHEREAS: According to Canadian Heritage, from 2008 to August 2021,

almost 450 news outlets have closed, with nearly 63 of those closures happening since the COVID-19 pandemic began, and

WHEREAS: 29 municipalities — home to more than 13 million people in nine

provinces (including Alberta) — have passed motions since 2020

voicing support for journalism in aid of democracy
