


Call To Artists



VIEWPOINT GALLERY

Viewpoint Gallery offers local artists and curators of all backgrounds the chance to exhibit original work. Run by City of Red Deer and located at 5205 48 Avenue in downtown Red Deer, it features 875 sq. ft. of exhibit space and 80 linear feet for hanging, with solo and group shows running 2–3 months.

Proposals are adjudicated by community and City art experts. The gallery offers visitors opportunities to engage with artists and their work through monthly First Friday receptions and Artist Talks. Exhibiting artists are offered an honorarium based on CARFAC's Fee Schedule for "Exhibitions in Other Public Spaces". Successful Artists' proposals will be programmed into one remaining spot in 2026 and all of 2027.



CORRIDOR COMMUNITY GALLERY

Corridor Community Gallery provides a public venue for local artists – both emerging and established – to share their talents and interests with the community. It is a City of Red Deer-run gallery located in the lower level of the Don Moore Recreation Centre in downtown Red Deer at 4501 47A Ave.. The gallery features nine 24x30 inch frames and there is also a display cabinet available for ceramic/3D works. Group and solo exhibitions typically run two to three months. This is an unpaid exhibition opportunity.

Submissions to Corridor Community Gallery are accepted on an ongoing basis. Successful proposals will be programmed into two remaining spots in 2026 and into 2027.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: Friday, May 1, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. MST

This call is open to artists and curators working in any visual art media, including but not limited to: sculpture, painting, printmaking, lettering arts, ceramics, fibre arts, glass, fine craft, jewellery, digital art, mixed media, photography, film, video and performance art.

Applicants must be Canadian residents. Preference will be given to residents of Red Deer and Central Alberta.

SUBMISSION INFORMATION →

ADJUDICATION

Submissions to Viewpoint Gallery will be reviewed by an adjudication committee that includes community art leaders and representatives from the City of Red Deer. This group changes annually. Proposals will be assessed based on:

- Consistency and quality of work
- Demonstrated commitment to serious practice
- Strength of proposed themes
- Ensuring a diversity of artists are represented
- Suitability for display in a public space

Submissions to Corridor Community Gallery are not adjudicated, but will be assessed on fit for the space and diversity of artists' voices.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Complete the fillable PDF application form with the following:

- Complete contact information
- Brief description of the proposed exhibition
- Artist's/Curator's statement related to the proposed work and/or your artistic practice
- Artist's/Curator's biography
- CV or arts resume

SUBMIT IMAGES & IMAGE LIST

- **5-10 .jpeg images of artwork in the proposal**
 - Name each file as follows: **number_last_name_title.jpg** (Ex: 3_Picasso_Guerica.jpg)
 - Images must be no larger than **1MB each**
- **A numbered image list** which corresponds to the images provided and includes:
 - Artist's last name, title of artwork, date completed, media, dimensions
 - For video, sound or similar media, use a sharing platform to store your work and provide links and passwords to the files in your image list
