

CITY OF RED DEER LOAN BYLAW Westerner Exposition Association Loan Bylaw

Red Deer City Council proposes to pass the following bylaw to provide for a five-year loan in the amount of up to \$1,000,000 to the Westerner Exposition Association. The loan is for the purpose of assisting with operations in the form of short-term bridge financing. The public may inspect the proposed bylaw at Legislative Services, City Hall, during regular office hours.

The electors may submit a separate petition with respect to this bylaw calling for a vote of the electors to determine whether the proposed bylaw should be passed. The petition must meet the formal requirements of Sections 221-226 of the Municipal Government Act and be filed with the Manager, Legislative Services within 15 days after the last date the proposed bylaw is advertised. The last date of advertisement for this bylaw is **March 31, 2023.** Any petition will be public information. MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION DECISIONS

On March 22, 2023 the Municipal Planning Commission issued the following decisions for development permit applications.

Discretionary Use Denials:

South Hill

Aggregate Design Studio - Development of an Events Centre as an Accessory Use to a Hotel, with a variance to the minimum requirement of 577 parking stalls to a proposed 551 parking stalls, a 26 parking stall (4.5% reduction), a variance to the minimum front yard from 15m to 6.44m, and a variance to the on-site landscaping from 40% (6,264m²) to 26% (I,274m²), to be located at 3310 50 Avenue.

You may appeal discretionary approvals and denials to the Red Deer Subdivision and Development Appeal Board at appeals@reddeer.ca prior to 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 12, 2023. You may not appeal a permitted use unless it involves a relaxation, variation or misinterpretation of the Land Use Bylaw. NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF RED DEER CITY COUNCIL

Red Deer City Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, April 17, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. in Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall to consider Land Use Bylaw Amendment 3357/F-2023 to rezone 3718 46 Street, in the Eastview neighbourhood, from R1A Residential (Semi Detached Dwelling/Duplex) District to R2 Residential (Medium Density) District.

Late submissions will not be included in the published Council Agenda. Written comments must be received by the Clerk, Legal & Legislative Services by the deadline in order to be included in the published Council Agenda.

Material(s) submitted for Council's consideration at the Public Hearing must form part of the public record and will appear on the Council Agenda in the same format that they are received by the Clerk. Personal information will not be redacted. The Clerk may withhold a public submission from the Council Agenda if the Clerk, after consulting legal counsel, concludes the submission contains: hate speech; discriminatory language; or defamatory language.

If you miss the deadline to submit written comments, have additional information to share, or wish to speak directly to Council, you may still participate by notifying the City Clerk prior to the end of the business day prior to the commencement of the meeting during which the Public Hearing will be held at 403-342-8132 or email publichearings@reddeer.ca.

Any person who wishes to address Council on this Public Hearing matter may do so for a period of five (5) minutes. The five (5) minutes does not include the time required to answer questions from City Council. Persons addressing Council shall limit their comments to this Public Hearing matter and the recommendations being discussed.
