

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF RED DEER CITY COUNCIL

Red Deer City Council will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, July 14, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. in Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall to consider:

1. Zoning Bylaw Amendment 3357/A-2026. An external application to create a site exception for Units #11 and #16, 7875 48 Ave to allow Merchandise Sales and Rentals and a Commercial Entertainment Facility as discretionary uses within these units.
2. Zoning Bylaw Amendment 3357/K-2026. An external application to rezone 6817 52 Ave, located in the Normandeau neighbourhood from Industrial Business Support Zone: I-1 to Major Area Commercial Zone: C-4 to allow for additional commercial opportunities.

City Council will receive comments from any person claiming to be affected by the proposed bylaw and will consider these at the Public Hearing. The public is welcome to participate in this Public Hearing by submitting written comments or by participating in the Public Hearing in person. Members of the public may make a request to the Clerk to speak to a Public Hearing from a remote location. The request must be received by the Clerk by the end of the business day prior to the commencement of the Meeting during which the Public Hearing will be held. The Clerk will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the request.

Late submissions will not be included in the published Council Agenda. Written comments must be received by the Clerk, Legislative Services by the deadline in order to be included in the published Council Agenda. Members can attend the Public Hearing to present their comments directly to Council during the Public Hearing. Members who wish to speak will have an opportunity to register directly prior to the commencement of the Public Hearing on a first come first serve basis.

Material(s) submitted for Council's consideration at the Public Hearing must form part of the public record and will appear on the Council Agenda in the same format that they are received by the Clerk. Personal information will not be redacted. The Clerk may withhold a public submission from the Council Agenda if the Clerk, after consulting legal counsel, concludes the submission contains: hate speech; discriminatory language; or defamatory language.

Members of the public may make a request to the Clerk to utilize technology to show images, videos, presentations and other visual aids during a Public Hearing. The request must be received by the Clerk by the end of the business day prior to the commencement of the Meeting during which the Public Hearing will be held. The Clerk will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the request.

Any person who wishes to address Council on this Public Hearing matter may do so for a period of five (5) minutes. The five (5) minutes does not include the time required to answer questions from City Council. Persons addressing Council shall limit their comments to this Public Hearing matter and the recommendations being discussed.

In accordance with section 70 of the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act, the City of Red Deer has been issued an amendment to the existing Approval No. 1091-03-00 by Alberta Environment and Protected Areas. The amendment is to revise some clauses in the existing approval related to sludge disposal. The Red Deer Wastewater System is located at Section 34 Township 38 Range 27 West of the 4th Meridian.

The *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* may provide you a right of appeal against this decision to the Alberta Environmental Appeals Board.
